ORDER


Upon consideration of the restoration of federal appropriations on November 12, 2025, and the resulting termination of conditions addressed in General Order 2025-02 (“Court Operations in the Absence of an Appropriation or Continuing Resolution”) and General Order 2025-04, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. As of November 12, 2025, full funding for the federal government has been restored. Accordingly, any operational adjustments implemented under General Order 2025-02 are no longer necessary. All provisions of General Order 2025-02 are therefore terminated effective November 12, 2025.
2. General Order 2025-04 is likewise terminated, except for its provisions extending deadlines in cases involving the United States or its agencies. Those extensions remain in effect and shall be applied as outlined in paragraph 3 below.
3. All deadlines extended by General Order 2025-04 shall be recalculated based on the restoration of funding on November 12, 2025, such that each extended deadline shall now expire on the date prescribed by General Order 2025-04, measured from November 12, 2025.
4. Except as stated herein, no additional extensions or accommodations shall apply absent further order of the Court.
